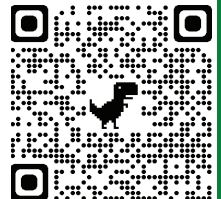

We have been parishioners of St. Anthony for over 20 years. My wife Tess serves as a Eucharistic Minister, and my sons Paolo and Rafael were altar servers from grammar to high school. In 2007 I was appointed lector and two years after, I became a Eucharistic Minister as well. Beginning with the Celebration of Mass on October 5, 1975, the Diamond Jubilee Year for St. Anthony's was filled with activities each month with several of our former priests returning to celebrate Mass. Several of the Societies held various socials culminating the year with a Concelebrated Mass on October 23, 1976 and Dinner-Dance following at the Fountain Restaurant in Belleville. The Historical Committee of St. Anthony's, (Lebro Charles, Robert J. Sibilia, Betty Forte and Pat Forte) relying on their own memories and obtaining much information by interviewing many different parishioners, had compiled the history for the first 75 years of our Parish specifically for their Diamond Jubilee Year. We are truly grateful for the work they did and consider it a blessing to be able to take this step back in time as we look forward to more history of St. Anthony of Padua Parish.
