A Kernel of History

(Part 2)

The people of the newly established St. Anthony of Padua Parish purchased land on Franklin Street near the corner of Lake Street. The wood frame building was built where we now have our parking lot on the side of the church. It had a basement about 70 feet long and 35 feet wide. It had a single belfry centrally located at the front of the church, with a peaked roof. The interior of the church consisted of the pews and main altar (made of wood) and two side altars. The ceiling was flat and made of metal with ornate designs. In the center of the ceiling surrounded by a golden oval frame about 15 x 12 feet was a beautiful colored painting on cloth of the Blessed Mother holding the Baby Jesus, with sky in the background and the world beneath her feet. There was an organ loft just above the entrance and two confession boxes—one on either side of the entrance. The walls were also made of metal with imprinted designs. There were six windows on each side with the Stations of the Cross in between each window. The pulpit was on the left-hand side of the sanctuary as was the entrance to the sacristy. The capacity of the church was approximately 150 people. Later, the building would be used as a parish center.
