# A Kernel of History

(Part 26)

In September 1980, St. Anthony School experienced a complete change over from religious teachers to lay teachers. Sr. Claire Pisaneschi was named the new Principal; however, she would reside in the nearby St. Francis Convent. The turnover of staff was due primarily to the shortage of religious teachers. It was in this year that the convent ceased to be a residence and was occupied instead by youth ministry offices. This arrangement, however, was unsuccessful and shortly afterwards the youth ministry moved to the Blue Room and Gym (the old church) on Franklin Street. Shortly after that, Miss Frances McCarthy retired after 20 years as Kindergarten teacher at St. Anthony's School. She will be remembered as one of the most loving teachers at our school, who, in the early years, would have more than 35 children in class at a time.

## THE SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION

Confirmation is the sacrament by which Catholics receive a special outpouring of the Holy Spirit. Through Confirmation, the Holy Spirit gives them the increased ability to practice their Catholic faith in every aspect of their lives and to witness Christ in every situation.

The effects of Confirmation are as follows:

- ◆ An increased portion of the gifts of the Holy Spirit: wisdom, knowledge, right judgment, understanding, courage, piety, and fear of the Lord
- ◆ A deepening and strengthening of the grace received at Baptism, which is considered the presence of God in the soul
- ◆ A more intimate relationship with Jesus Christ
- ◆ A closer bond with the Catholic Church
- ◆ The ability to take a greater, more mature role in the Church's mission of living the Christian faith daily and witnessing to Christ everywhere
- ◆ A special mark, or character, on the soul that can never be erased

Each person's ability to embrace these effects depends on his or her openness to the sacrament and willingness to accept it as God's personal gift.
