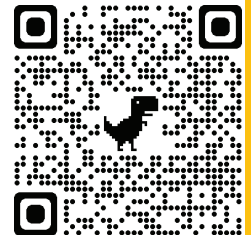

A Kernel of History

(Part 27)

In January of 1981, the Belleville Optimist Club, headed by parishioners George Sbarra and Jim Risoli, organized a breakfast in the school cafeteria for the benefit of the Parish. Then, for Easter, the Cub Scouts distributed bottles of Holy Water to each parish family for the 9th year in a row. It was estimated that they had given out a total of 10,000 bottles under the direction of devoted Den Leader Mary Mazza. For Mother's Day that year, the Holy Name Society sponsored their Annual Mother's Day Communion Breakfast celebrating 50 continuous years of honoring the Mothers of the Parish. The Rosary Altar Society completed the year's celebrations by hosting an evening in spirituality on October 12 with Fr. Thomas Gillick as guest speaker. Fr. Gillick was a much-loved priest for many years at St. Anthony's from 1937-1956. He had captured the hearts of many through his work with the youth. Under the direction of Terri Mattia, the evening began with Benediction and the recitation of the Rosary and placing of the Rosary Beads on the Blessed Mother. A reception followed.
