From the desk of the Administrator....

My dear parishioners and friends,

"The purpose in life is to find the purpose in life."

This statement I found in a cartoon caricature is quite witty and intriguing. Though it is a kind of 'begging the question' statement, it is a paraphrase of what the American author Robert Byrne said: *"The purpose of life is a life of purpose."* Byrne explains that "to clear the word 'purpose,' we have to justify the idea of what exactly is the meaning of each individual...the point is, we are all different individuals, and we have a different and meaningful purpose to contribute in this world."

I believe that the above explanation is an old adage. Jesus lived it out when He accepted it saying: "It was for this purpose that I came to this hour." Even the surrounding circumstances in His life and the perception of the impending pain and suffering He had to endure, He chose to accept the meaningful yet painful purpose He had to contribute in this world, as willed by the Father. Only in so doing did He glorify the Father and was glorified Himself.

Yes, each one of us has to accept and execute our individual purpose in this world. I, for one, had to accept it when God, through the instrumentality of Cardinal Tobin, asked me to take on the new mission and ministry here at St. Anthony's. Although my life and ministry were going smoothly as associate priest in different parishes, I now have to face and willingly accept my purpose. Using the words of Jesus, I could say that *"It was for this purpose that I came to the here and now of this parish."* And I know that together with you, my dear parishioners and friends, we glorify God and we too will be glorified with Jesus.

We have to simply believe and be wholly confident that with more challenges, the sweeter and more glorious our successes will be.


May St. Anthony of Padua intercede for us always and the Good Lord continue to bless us!

when you lived upon the earth.**


**You were known, even then, as a great Wonder-worker,




